G.A.I.N. is a qualified 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization and a Michigan Non-profit Corporation

**23 spay/neuter clinics** were held, where **899 cats**, including **565 free roaming cats**—254 trapped in our TNR program—were altered, avoiding hundreds, if not thousands, of unwanted kittens.

Since G.A.I.N.'s formation in 2014 a total of **6,649 cats and kittens** have been altered through these clinics.

**97 dogs** and **25 cats** were vaccinated or microchipped through two vaccine clinics.

**19 dogs** were altered through local veterinarians or low cost clinics through the Mike Harrison Memorial Fund.

**213 cats and kittens** were adopted into loving homes through G.A.I.N.'s foster program.

Since G.A.I.N.'s formation in 2014 a total of **2,641 cats and kittens** have been adopted through our foster program.

**29 cats** were placed through our Barn Cat working cat program.

**39 pet owners** were served through G.A.I.N.'s Companions program, which provided approximately \$10,000 of financial assistance for vet care to lower income pet owners.

**354 pet owners** were assisted through our pet food bank, ensuring **over 1,075 pets** did not go hungry.
